AGREEMENT FOR RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY FOR A MINOR CHILD

I request permission for my child to participate in cross-country riding and foxhunting with the Bear Creek Hounds / Bear Creek Hunt / Bear Creek Foxhounds Hunt.

I fully understand that cross-country riding, foxhunting and riding to hounds (which includes riding over fences, obstacles and rough or steep terrain) are very dangerous activities. I have read and understood this release and I wish to allow my child to participate in these activities knowing them to be dangerous. I further accept and assume all risks of injury, damage and death to my child or my property howsoever caused. I represent and warrant that I have the authority to give this release.

In exchange for being permitted to participate in these activities, for myself, my heirs, guardians, executors and legal representatives, I release and agree not to make or bring any claim of any kind against the Bear Creek Hounds / Bear Creek Hunt / Bear Creek Foxhounds Hunt or its Masters, Officers, Directors, Members, Employees or Guests, or any Landowners, Landholders, tenants or any other persons making available property for use by the Bear Creek Hounds / Bear Creek Hunt / Bear Creek Foxhounds Hunt, for any injury (including death) to me, or any damage to my property whether from anyone's negligence or not, or any other cause, arising from my participation in Horseback riding, Foxhunting or related activities; And I also agree that should any person make or bring a claim because of any injury to me (including death), or for any damage to my property, I will keep all those released by this agreement free of any damages or costs incurred because of such claims.
